## Conditions of Approval

1. The appropriate stock permit must be obtained from the Local Lands Services and a copy of this forwarded to Council soon after receipt for this permit to become valid;
2. The applicant shall abide by all the provisions of the Local Lands Act 2013 and Local Land Services Regulation 2014
3. The applicant shall display the required signage; when stock are on or adjacent to a road way, and removed when stock are no longer present;
4. The distance over which stock are being grazed does not exceed 2kms at any one time;
5. When stock are being moved along the road the road, warning signs shall be no further than 5kms apart; that at least one person shall be attending the stock at all times;
6. That the stock may only be present on a public road during daylight hours
7. The permit holder must produce a copy of this permit to authorised Council officers when required to do so;
8. Upper Hunter Shire Council reserves the right to terminate the approval at any time within the permit period;
9. Any stock that die or are injured must be removed from the public road reserve within 24 hours;
10. Upper Hunter Shire Council will not be liable for any damage to persons or property due to any incident occurring whilst the stock are located within the road reserve;
11. The permit holder will accept all risks associated with the grazing of stock on a public road and make good any damage to roadside furniture and/or adjoining fences.
