

What is Sport 4 U Upper Hunter Shire?

Sport 4 U Upper Hunter Shire provides an opportunity for children living in the Upper Hunter to actively participate in community sport and recreation, regardless of their financial circumstances. Eligible participants aged between 5-15 years can apply for up to \$130 financial assistance to contribute towards club fees. The fees will be passed on directly to *Sport 4 U* registered sports clubs through Upper Hunter Shire Council.

Sport 4 U is an inclusive program suitable for people living with a disability.

Based on a program developed by the Department of Sport and Recreation Western Australia.

Am I Eligible?

- Applicants must be aged 5-15 years
- Applicants family must have a Health Care Card or Pension Concession Card.
- Applicants primary place of residence must be within the Upper Hunter Shire.

How do I get involved?

Step 1

Applicants complete the *Sport 4 U Application Form* and submit it to Council to be validated. Applicants must attach a copy of their families Health Care Card or Pension Concession Card.

Step 2

Council validates the Application Form and returns the form to the applicant. Approved applicants have to join their nominated club within **6 weeks** from approval date to be eligible for funding.

Step 3

Applicant submits the approved Application Form to the club upon joining and pays the membership fee minus the approved *Sport 4 U* funding.

Step 4

The club invoices Council for the approved cost of the fees up to \$130 per child after the applicant has been approved by Council and paid the share of the membership fee.

What else do I need to know?

- Funding will assist in covering the cost of fees to join the nominated sports club, which may include other related costs identified by the club and approved by Council.
- Applicants can receive a maximum of \$130 per child per year (01/01/2016 - 31/12/2016); subject to budget availability.
- Fees are only for the nominated registered season.
- No retrospective fees will be paid.
- No limits to the number of applicants per family as long as the criteria are met.
- Sports clubs must be based in the Upper Hunter, be not-for-profit, affiliated with their State Sporting Body and have signed and agreed to the *Sport 4 U* Terms and Conditions.
