Applications to downsize 32mm and larger must be accompanied by a consulting engineer's report. The engineer's report is to include comment on the back flow prevention device if installed.

Applications for downsize of any connection where the premises is supporting fire service must contain a consultant Engineers report.

Downsize of meter connection will affect water flow and pressure to the property. The proposed meter side must comply with the relevant BCA & NSW Plumbing and Drainage codes.
