

ROADS - POLICY - MAINTENANCE – Dust Seal Criteria

Policy

Request by rural ratepayers for the gravel road adjacent to their home, dairy, stables, to be bitumen sealed to reduce dust.

Objective

To meet rural ratepayers' requirements, within Council's budgetary constraints.

Procedures/Practice

The following procedure is to apply to all private works requests for 'dust seal':

- A written agreement or private works form must be completed and signed by the applicant prior to carrying out the work.
- Sealing costs to be borne by the applicant.
- Subject to existing adequate pavement and drainage,
- Council will cover the cost of labour and plant to undertake pavement preparation works.
- Pavement to be a minimum of 300mm thick, any additional gravel required to achieve this will be at the applicant's expense.
- Any additional drainage works to achieve Council's standards will be at the applicant's expense.
- Each design and cost estimate to be determined on a site-specific basis.
- Minimum seal length 100 metres and full width of road in accordance with Council's minimum width of pavement for the classification of road.
- Cost to be based on Council's internal charges.
- If the work is undertaken in accordance with Council's standards, Council is to maintain the sealed section of road.


