RETHINK your waste

RETHINK WHERE YOU PLACE YOUR WASTE

All of the waste that is placed in your general waste (red lid) bin goes to landfill.

Landfilling is expensive. All waste that enters a landfill attracts the NSW Waste Levy. Then there are operating and landfill remediation costs. These costs are passed on to the community.

Landfills can emit greenhouse gases,

attract vermin, leach into groundwater and create litter.

The less waste that enters your general waste bin the better it will be for the environment and our hip pockets.

REDUCE

- Only buy what you need – use a shopping list
- Buy quality items that will last
- Borrow from or share items with a library, friend or family
- Avoid single use items
- Bring along your own reusable water bottle or coffee cup
- Purchase items with minimal packaging. Some shops allow you to bring your own jars

REUSE

- Make extra cash by selling unwanted items *still in good condition* online or hold a garage sale and get to know your neighbours
- Donate your unwanted items to a local charity shop if in good condition.
- Donate old blankets and towels to animal shelters
- Learn to repair items instead of throwing them out and replacing

RECYCLE

- Place recyclables in the bin or take to the Waste Management Facility. Use the A-Z guide to choose the right way to recycle
- Recycle hazardous waste by taking them to the Score Community Recycling Centre (CRC)
- Take glass, plastic and metal beverage containers to a Return and Earn facility
- Take soft plastics to your local grocery store to be recycled
- Compost your food waste or keep a worm farm
