- 8. Is it likely that the Library / Campbell's Corner will be ringfenced from this committee as well?
- 9. Were other airport businesses given the same opportunity to move to Cameron's airstrip on Nandowra Road and did council do work to get the strip ready?
- 10. With regards to notifications to airport businesses, what arrangement did Council make with Mr Owens from East Coast Aircraft Maintenance and was he happy?
- 11. With regards to the Scone Airport, what are the cost saving measures taken by UHSC to bring the overall project into budget and can an updated report be provided.
- 12. With regards to the Scone Airport, how does the budget now differ to original project that was initially presented to the ratepayers and can a report be provided please?
- 13. With regards to the Scone Airport, what proportion of the overall budget is going into the aviation museum versus the airside infrastructure compared to the original plans.
- 14. With regards to Scone Airport and the surface of the runway sprayseal and hotmix (FOD foreign object debris). What is the expected durability and is UHSC aware owners of small aeroplanes are concerned for potential propeller damage as a result of the sprayseal that is being applied. Is UHSC confident that there will be no damage?
