

The annual bulky waste collection service is available to households with an existing kerbside waste collection service in Upper Hunter Shire.

**Scone ..... 17-18 October 2020**

**Aberdeen, Blandford,  
Bunnan, Cassilis, Gundy,  
Merriwa, Moonan Flat,  
Murrurundi, Parkville,  
Wingen ..... 24-25 October 2020**

- Ensure items are secure to avoid windblown littering.
- All waste is expected to be collected by 30 October 2020.
- The collection service will not return to any street that has already been serviced.
- Any waste placed by kerbsides outside of this 2 week period will be considered illegal waste and fines could apply.

### How much you can put out

Each household may put out a maximum equivalent of one standard box trailer load (2m<sup>3</sup>). Anything in excess of this may not be collected. It will be up to you to remove this uncollected excess waste, which will be considered as illegally dumped waste once the bulky waste service has ceased.

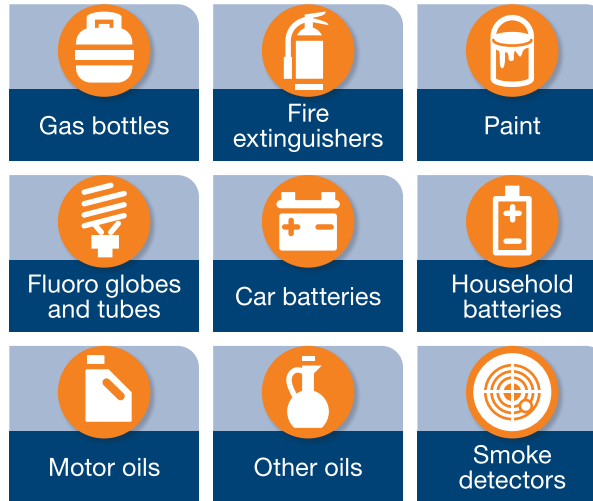

## STACK YOUR WASTE INTO TWO TIDY PILES

Keep your total waste under the capacity of one standard box trailer load (2m<sup>3</sup>).

Stack waste neatly and securely on the edge of the kerb.

**DO NOT BLOCK** the footpath or roadway.

### Pile 1

## Garden Organics

Hedge or shrub prunings, twigs and leaves.  
Small branches up to 150mm diameter.



### Pile 2

## Bulky Household Waste

Larger items such as unrepairable furniture, old floor coverings and broken glass are accepted.

### ✓ Floor Coverings

Rolled with lengths up to 1.5m

### ✓ Furniture

Except mattresses

### ✓ Broken glass

Carefully wrapped in newspaper

## NOT ACCEPTED

Take these items to any Shire waste facility for recycling or appropriate treatment. Fees apply.

- ✗ Mattresses
- ✗ Electronics: e.g kitchen appliances, televisions, computers and peripheral devices
- ✗ Metals: e.g whitegoods, car batteries, metal bed frames, hot water systems
- ✗ Commercial, trade, industrial or shop waste. E.g. plumbing fixtures, water tanks and tiling
- ✗ Tyres, wrecked motor vehicles, motor vehicle parts and engines
- ✗ Building and demolition materials, concrete, bricks and insulation
- ✗ Household hazardous waste, eg. paint, spray paint, asbestos, solvents, chemicals, cleaners and unwanted medicines
- ✗ Lengths of material longer than 1.5m (excluding lounges etc)
- ✗ Small machinery containing fuel or oil
- ✗ Liquids of any sort including fuel and oil
- ✗ Gas bottles and fire extinguishers
- ✗ Garden waste greater than 1m long or 150mm in diameter, loose grass clippings, soil and stones
- ✗ Tree stumps and heavy branches
- ✗ Mirrors or glass panels (not wrapped for transport)
- ✗ Food scraps, recyclable material and regular household garbage
