The annual bulky waste collection service is available to households with an existing kerbside waste collection service in Upper Hunter Shire.

Scone, Gundy and Moonan Flat October 14 - 18, 2024

Murrurundi, Blandford, Wingen, Parkville and Bunnan Ocotber 21 - 25, 2024

Cassilis, Merriwa and Aberdeen 28 October - 1 November, 2024

- Ensure items are secure to avoid windblown littering.
- All waste is expected to be collected by 1 November 2024.
- The collection service will not return to any street that has already been serviced.
- Any waste placed by kerbsides outside of this 3 week period will be considered illegal waste and fines could apply.

How much you can put out

Each household may put out a maximum equivalent of one standard box trailer load (2m³). Anything in excess of this may not be collected. It will be up to you to remove this uncollected excess waste, which will be considered as illegally dumped waste once the bulky waste service has ceased.

HOW TO STACK YOUR BULKY WASTE

Keep your total waste under the capacity of one standard box trailer load (2m³).

Stack waste neatly and securely on the edge of the kerb.

DO NOT BLOCK the footpath or roadway.

Larger items such as unrepairable furniture, old floor coverings and broken glass are accepted.

- ✓ Floor Coverings
 Rolled with lengths up to 1.5m
- Furniture

 Except mattresses
- ✓ Broken glass
 Carefully wrapped in newspaper

NOT ACCEPTED

Take these items to any Shire waste facility for recycling or appropriate treatment. Fees may apply.

- **★** Garden Organics With the introduction of FOGO, garden organics are no longer accepted.
- Mattresses and Tyres are also prohibited, however a separate free drop off event will be held in 2025
- ★ Electronics: e.g kitchen appliances, televisions, computers and peripheral devices
- Metals: e.g whitegoods, car batteries, metal bed frames, hot water systems
- ★ Commercial, trade, industrial or shop waste. E.g. plumbing fixtures, water tanks and tiling
- Wrecked motor vehicles, motor vehicle parts and engines
- Building and demolition materials, concrete, bricks and insulation
- ✗ Household hazardous waste, eg. paint, spray paint, asbestos, solvents, chemicals, cleaners and unwanted medicines
- Lengths of material longer than 1.5m (excluding lounges etc)
- X Small machinery containing fuel or oil
- X Liquids of any sort
- X Gas bottles and fire extinguishers
- X Tree stumps, trunks and branches
- Mirrors or glass panels (not wrapped for transport)
- X Food scraps, recyclable material and regular household garbage
